networkMaryland **Is**

- Valuable State Asset For Cost Reduction
 - Draw Down \$125M Annual IT Spend
- 6 Points Of Presence, All MD. LATA's
 - Easton, Hagerstown, Annapolis, UMCP, Baltimore, LaPlata
- A Public Sector Network
 - 22 Agencies, 1 County, Higher Education

networkMaryland **Is**

- Guided By An Advisory Board
- Layer 2 Service - Inter LATA
 - Video, Data, File Sharing etc.
 - Between Locations Of An Agency
- Internet Service Provider (ISP)
 - With Qwest and MCI
 - Fail Over Service

networkMaryland **Is**

- Statewide Government Intranet (SwGI)
 - Financial Management Information System (FMIS)
- Built On A 40 Year Resource Share Agreement
- Fiber Optic Based Now
- A Mixture Of Leased & State Owned Facilities
- Being Built Through Inter Agency Cooperation
 - MDOT, MPT, Sailor, DBM

networkMaryland **Will Become**

- 18 Jurisdictions

- 19 Points Of Presence

- Overlay Multi Service Centers

- Multiple Agencies In Same Area Aggregated

- Eliminate Duplicative And Underutilized

- Internet 2 Peer For Higher Education

- Baltimore Education Research Network (BERNet)

 - Microwave When Appropriate
- Platform For Statewide Technology Consolidation
 - Email
 - Virus Blocking
 - Spam Filtering
 - Virtual Trunking

- O&M Cost Covered BY DBM

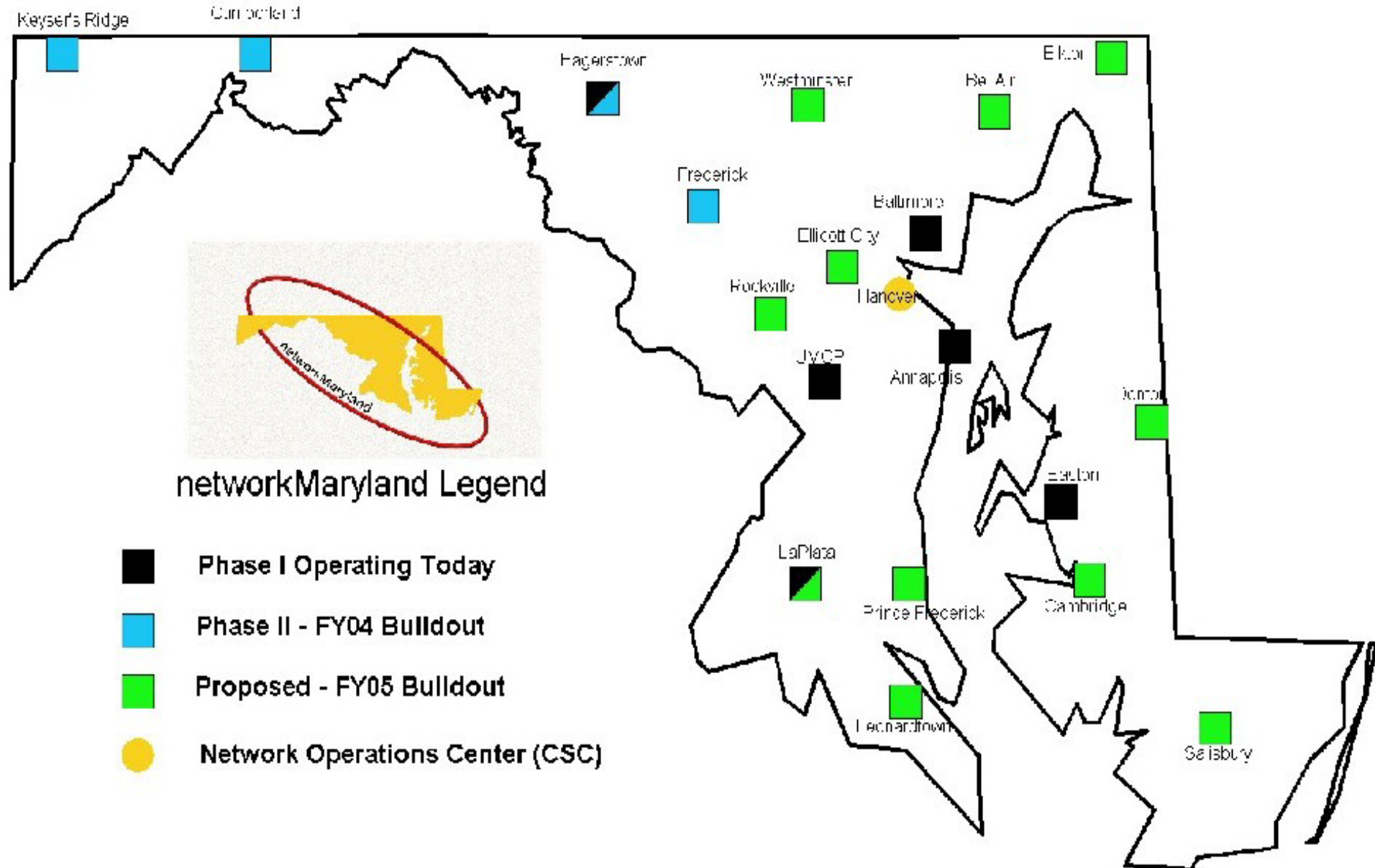
- No Charge Back To Agencies

- A Common Carrier
- Private Sector Service Provider
- To Be Built Out Beyond 25 Jurisdictions
(One Point Of Presence Per Jurisdiction)
- A Back Up To Commercial Services
- Funded To Be Ubiquitous

- Spare Fiber To Elkton
- Spare Fiber UMCP-Baltimore-Annapolis
- Space On 220 Wireless Infrastructure Towers
- Potential Fiber Across The Bay Bridge
- Preliminary Talks With Cavalier, Bay Country, Easton Utilities

networkMaryland **Economic Development**


- Make Resource Share Available To
 - Companies That Want To Build Broadband Networks
 - Companies That Can Exchange Assets Needed To Expand networkMaryland
 - Counties, Municipalities In Exchange For Access To Their Area Networks
 - Companies That Want To Grow In Or Move To Maryland

networkMaryland **Economic Development**

- Make networkMaryland Available To
 - Medical Research Facilities Such As Johns Hopkins
 - Higher Education Research Facilities
 - Via TEDCO To Incubator Companies
 - Via DBED To Induce Investment

networkMaryland **Summary**

- Different Than Originally Envisioned
- A More Clearly Defined Mission
- Substantially Less Expensive And Extensive
- A Cost Containment Asset
- Indirectly Contribute To Economic Development
- A More Efficient Government
- Can Centralize Statewide Functions
